Both Teams To Score - **Yes**

Angle: Back BTTS - Yes as a core pre-match position.

Reasoning: Newcastle have seen BTTS land in 8 of their last 9 league matches. Bournemouth have consistently found the net on the road, including two goals at the Emirates, but rarely keep clean sheets.

High

Over/Under Goals - **Over 2.5 Goals**

Angle: Look to back Over 2.5 goals in-play if the opening 15 minutes show high transitional speed.

Reasoning: The last three head-to-heads at St James' Park have featured over 3.5 goals. Newcastle averages 1.41 goals scored and 1.47 conceded, matching well with Bournemouth's high-tempo style.

Leading attacking threat for Newcastle, utilizing pace to exploit the flanks and delivering crucial final balls.
