## Match Summary

Liverpool host Chelsea at Anfield on May 9, 2026, in a crucial Premier League Matchday 36 clash. Chelsea, managed by Liam Rosenior and sitting 8th, are looking to capitalize on the hosts' depleted squad, relying heavily on top scorer Joao Pedro. **(Attacking Midfielder)**

With major attackers sidelined, Szoboszlai will be relied upon heavily for chance creation and goal contributions from midfield.

**Strengths**

- ✓ Strong midfield pressing led by Dominik Szoboszlai
- ✓ Solid central defensive core anchored by Virgil van Dijk
